Important Notes:

1. Registration Fee: Payable upon submission of Application Form. This fee is a one-off payment, not refundable nor transferable.
2. The deposit is non-transferable but refundable, provided that one **FULL** semester's written notice of withdrawal in advance is submitted to the school.
3. All fees must be paid before the commencement of the academic year. These fees are not refundable nor transferable and they cannot be prorated.
4. Tuition Fees are payable by semester. There are two (2) semesters in an academic year.
5. Tuition fee are invoiced every semester. These fees are payable before the beginning of the semester.
6. Meal plan, uniform, books (text books, e-books, workbooks & exercise books), educational digital apps, resources fee, co-curricular activities, overseas/outstation trip, educational trip and insurance will be billed separately.
7. All external exam fees are borne by students.
8. All fees are subjected to review and the management reserves the right to revise the terms and conditions.
