Story Mountains are useful for creative writing exercises and a wonderful way for students to plan and plot out a story before they begin writing, giving them a framework to guide them as they go.



























Mid-Autumn Festival

Mid autumn festival is derived from the custom of moon worshipping during the Zhou dynasty. The festival became more popular and is celebrated by more of the general














