














In IPC lesson this week, we discussed about the food we eat for breakfast and discovered that some of us shared the same interests in food choices.















## We Learn How To Write Essay In Mandarin









Group 2 - Amanda, Zhen Yin and Rachel presenting the factors that affect the rate of diffusion

The students were assigned to do research on the factors that affect the rate of diffusion. The students were able to collaborate well with each other. These are some screenshots of the presentation that the students have conducted.












# Year 11 Combined Science





