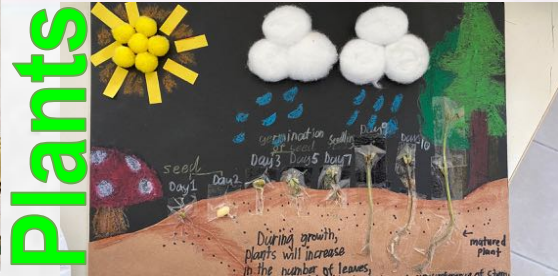
- ❖ It takes 24 trees to make 1 ton of newspaper

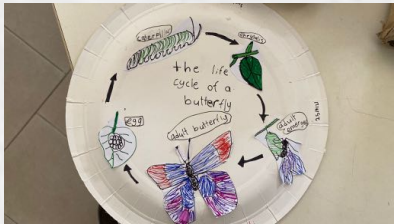
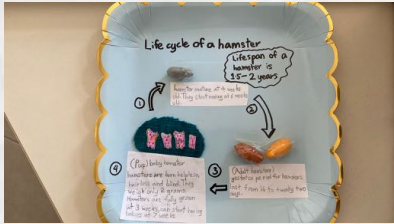

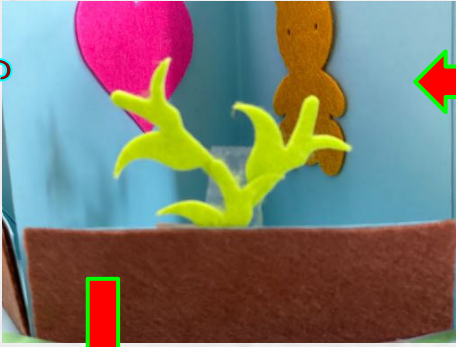

Growth Stages



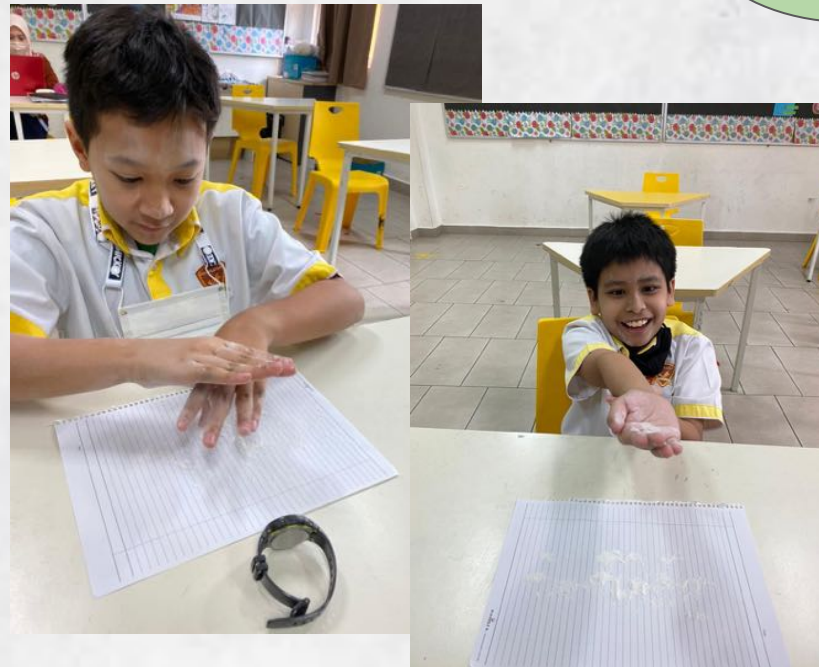
