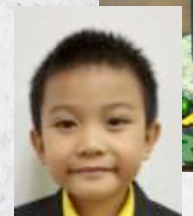

Interjections

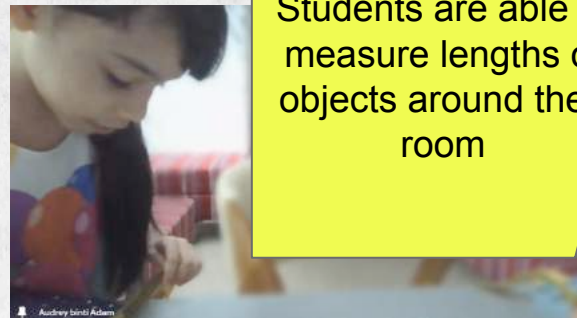
An interjection is a word that expresses emotions and feelings.



Hey! Boo! Phew! Oh no! Ah! Wow! Yuck! Jeez! Yeah!

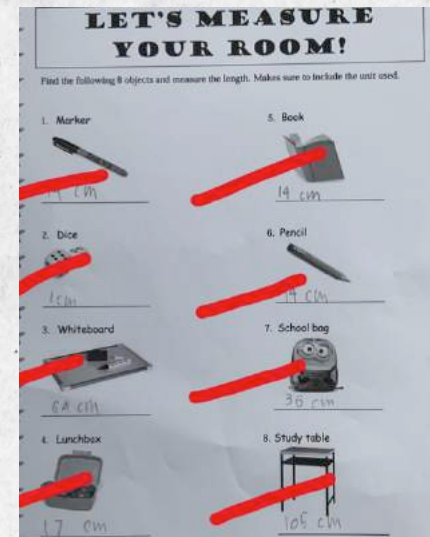
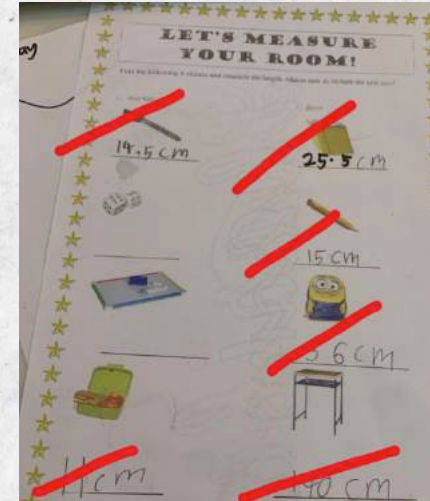

(17 December 1770 - 26 March 1827)

Beethoven is a influential composer who is often regarded as the first ever Romantic period composer. His musical style often shows a great contrast in dynamics and mood. My favourite piece of his is the Symphony no. 5, "Fate".

Frederic Chopin (1810-1849)

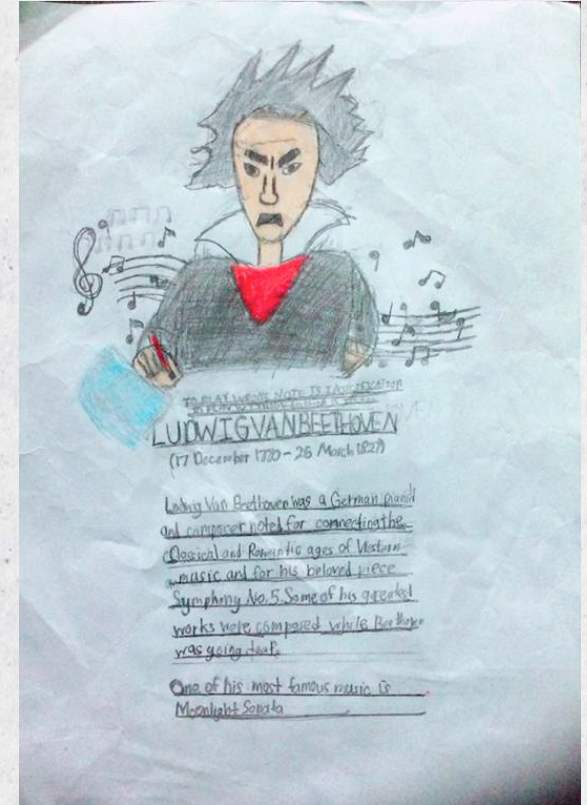
Chopin was a Polish composer and virtuoso pianist. He is considered one of the greatest Romantic Piano composers. His Piano works are often technically difficult, especially because deep expression is involved along with the importance of considering each detail in his music. My favorite his work is "Polonaise No. 6"

DECEMBER 5 1791

Mozart composed music in several genres, including opera and symphony. His most famous compositions included the motet Exsultate, Jubilate, K 165 (1773), the operas The Marriage of Figaro (1786) and Don Giovanni (1787), and the Jupiter Symphony (1788). He is known to be a genius.

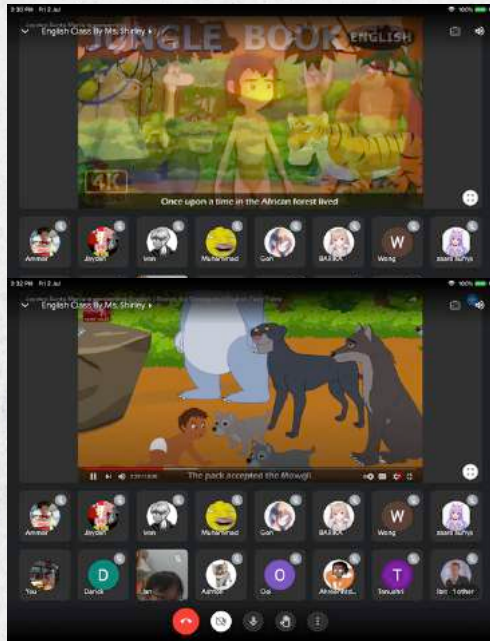

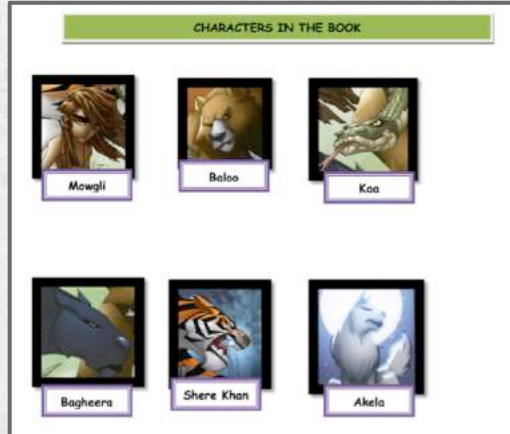

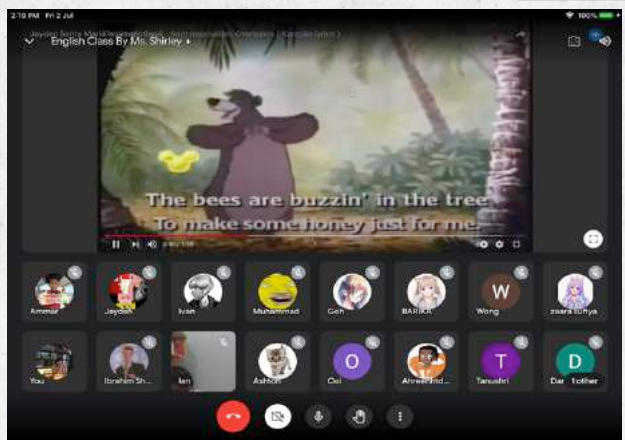


Literature Lesson Today

For the reader literature is simply beautiful, meaningful writing.



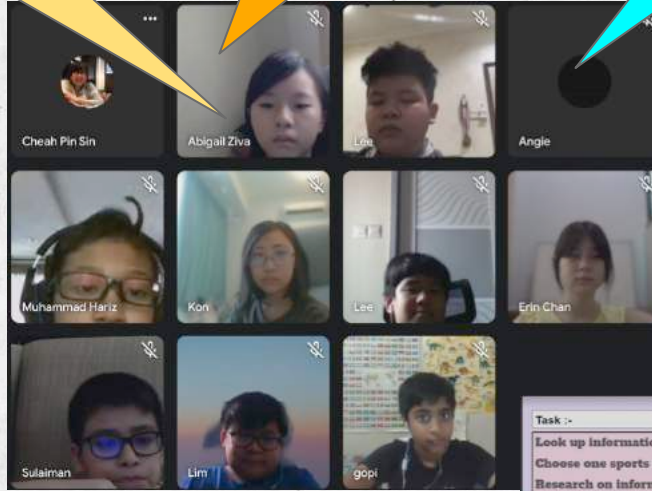
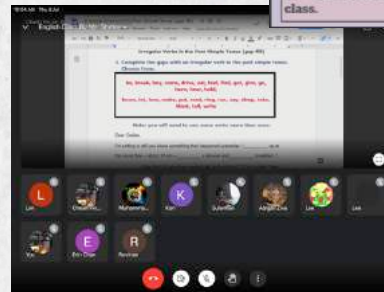
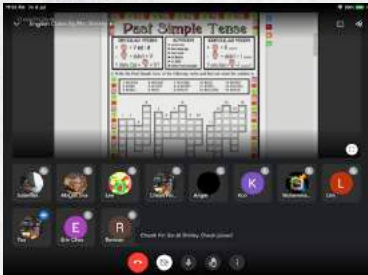
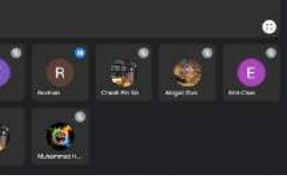
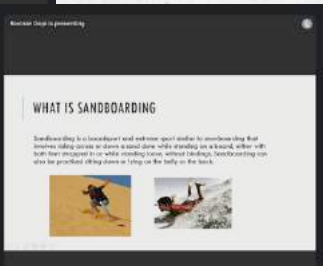
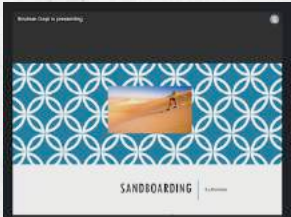
