
Group 6 = Jian teck + Yihan Solar Flares

A solar flare occurs whenever magnetic energy that has built up in the solar atmosphere is suddenly released. On the Sun's surface are huge magnetic loops called prominences. When they touch, they short circuit each other, setting off explosions known as solar flares.




Sunspots are areas where the magnetic field is about 2,500 times stronger than Earth's, much higher than anywhere else on the Sun. ... The sunspots appear relatively dark because the surrounding surface of the Sun (the photosphere) is about 10,000 degrees F., while the umbra is about 6,300 degrees F.

Grp 3= Yap Kai + Jeevanan Solar Cycles


The solar cycle is an approximately 11-year cycle experienced by the Sun. During the solar cycle, the Sun's stormy behavior builds to a maximum, and its magnetic field reverses. Then, the Sun settles back down to a minimum before another cycle begins.

- The solar wind is a stream of charged particles released from the upper atmosphere of the Sun, called the corona.
- The residue of nuclear fusion which takes place on the surface of the sun

Grp 4 = Boh Jin + Cherish Prominences





'sword way', 'sword path' or 'way of the sword')[1] is a modern Japanese martial art, descended from swordsmanship (kenjutsu), that uses bamboo swords (shinai) as well as protective armor (bōgu). It is widely practiced within Japan and has spread to many other nations across the world including in Malaysia.





A shinai (竹刀) is a Japanese sword typically made of bamboo used for practice and competition in kendo. Shinai are also used in other martial arts, but may be styled differently from kendo shinai, and represented with different characters. The light, soft wood used in a shinai distinguishes it from other wooden swords such as a bokken, which is generally made of heavier, sturdier wood.









# Moral Education : Loving Society, Ethics in Friendship, Healthy Living and Model Student.


