




1R students felt the joy of the spring festival when they followed teacher's instructions during Chinese lesson to complete their greeting card.





The Story of Chinese New Year



Chinese New Year is celebrated on the first day of Lunar New Year. It has been celebrated for more than 4,000 years. In ancient China, the New Year was probably held at various times, at the whim of the emperor. This celebration typically falls sometime between late January and mid-February and is celebrated by all the Chinese around the world.

To prepare for the new year, the Chinese will clean their homes, put up decorations such as lanterns, red packets, good wordings and get things ready for the New Year. New clothes are also bought before the celebration. Some families will be busy baking or making cookies too.

One day before Chinese New Year, all the family members will return home and have dinner together. This is known as the reunion dinner. Good food will be served at the dinner table and it is a good moment to spend time with our family members. At night, children will play firecrackers and count down to the New Year.

On the first day of Chinese New Year, everyone will dress in their best clothes and visit friends and relatives. No work is done on New Year's Day because it is believed that working on this special day will lead to hard work all year round. The 'Ang Pau' which symbolises blessings will be given to the children and those who are single. It is a meaningful and enjoyable celebration!

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


Animation and drawing was introduced to students to spark their interest in understanding about the China history.

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Practice is very important for Mathematics.


After each Mathematics lesson, it will be followed by calculation practices given by the teacher.
